NOTICE IS GIVEN that we are applying to the Consistory Court of the diocese for permission to carry out the following:

The installation/replacement of audiovisual components including:

- 3 x stereo amps in organ loft to be replaced by 3 x BBS2K in Comms rack sat on safe in vestry, with a new mixing desk (faceless);
- New hearing loop to be installed for nave and chancel, with old loop to be reused in Chapter House;
- Re-locate 3x Sennheiser XSW receivers in rack with new active antennae mounted on organ case at the west end;
- Install camera on organ case at the west end;
- 32" TV and camera on wall in chancel on a bracket facing east;
- 55" TV on mobile stand;
- Mobile workstation, bespoke, similar to computer workstation on wheels stored in the vestry;
- 2m wide retractable screen to the chancel arch behind the organ at low level;
- Replace the curtain to the privacy screen to the organ with a solid light oak timber infill and install a data projector to organist side of the screen;
- Associated wiring and connections.

All in accordance with Acoustic Solutions Yorkshire Ltd quotation no. 115 (account STRO01); Wilson Kennett Partnership drawing no. 500/75; Beautiful Wardrobe Company drawing dated 06/08/2020; annotated plan; photos and mock-up visualisations; and screen and camera specifications.

so that your letter reaches the registrar not later than 24/10/2020. A letter of objection must include your name and address and state whether you live in the parish and/or your name is entered on the church electoral roll of the parish or any other basis on which you have an interest in the matter.

Directions to petitioner

You must display this public notice (or a copy of it) for a continuous period of not less than 28 days, not counting the day on which it was put up or the day on which it is taken down, (or for such other period as the Court may direct and subject to any special directions of the registrar) in each of the following places:

1. on a notice board or in some other prominent position inside the church; and
2. on a notice board outside the church or in some other prominent position (whether on the outside of the church door or elsewhere) so that it can be read by the public.
